OUTDOOR RANGE RULES

ALCOHOL IS PROHIBITED AT EITHER RANGE.

1. During all club functions, the Range Officer shall be in complete charge of the range.
2. The club requires that hearing and eye protection be worn by all shooters and guest.
3. All children and guest must be supervised by a club member, who shall be responsible for their actions. **Do not loan out your key.**
4. No firearms shall have the action closed while people are forward of the firing line.
5. No buildings, walls, signs, or other range equipment shall be used to support or affix targets to.
6. Keep firearms pointed down range. Fire only at designated target areas. **Be sure of your target.**
7. Be sure no one is in the impact area during firing.
8. These rules shall be used in conjunction with the **TEN COMMANDMENTS OF GUN SAFETY.**
9. Shoot only on designated ranges. **All rounds must hit the designated impact area.**
(Not in the grass behind the target stand).
10. Shooting on the 300 yard range and the 100 yard practice range is on a first come first serve basis.
(This also includes the 300 yard and 200 yard north range.)
11. Be sure of your back stop.
12. All shooting on the 200 yard (north range) will be done in the area around the rifle stand.
13. Do not shoot at vertical uprights on target stands or affix any objects or targets to them.
14. Do not set objects on top of target stands to shoot at.
15. **Never shoot targets on the ground!**
16. Absolutely **NO GLASS** shall be used as targets.
17. No shooting of steel targets within 25 yards on the 100 yard practice range and must be 4-5 feet off the ground.
18. No shooting of steel targets on the North range.
19. Do not leave loaded weapons unattended.
20. Range gate will be locked at all times except when there is a match on the range.
21. Range lock will be changed every September.
22. Speed limit is 5 mph.
23. Park only in parking areas.
24. Do not drive on the berms at the 100 and 200 yard firing line.
25. Clean up your trash and used targets --and any that some slob has left.
26. Hours for the outdoor range is 8:00 am to dark.
27. In the winter months, do not come to the range if you cannot get back up the hill.
28. Bring a cardboard backer, paper targets and a staple gun with you to insure you have a target to shoot at.
29. **NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS CONSUMED BEFORE OR DURING SHOOTING.**
30. Any member will be subject to expulsion if they, or their guest do not abide by these rules.
